

Edge Sealing with Silicone

Difficulty Level: Easy

Silicone Edge Sealing is primary used when a frame is going to be used around the edge of the Lumicor panel.

If your Lumicor application will be exposed to moisture or may become wet during use (shower doors, vanity tops, etc...) it is important to seal the edges. Sealing the cut Lumicor edge sufficiently will prevent moisture from wicking into the sheet.

Materials

Tack Cloth Acid Free (non-corrosive) Silicone and applicator Recommended Silicones:

- DAP Titanium RTV
- Loctite Superflex non-corrosive RTV
- Dow Corning Silastic 1080 RTV

Optional: 3M 2090 Safe-Release Blue Painters Masking Tape, Router bit

Procedure

Clean edge using a tack cloth. Apply Silicone into frame and set panel into frame.

If no framing is used: Peel back masking approximately 1" and apply 3M tape to front and back surface along perimeter edges so that only the edge of the Lumicor is the only edge exposed. Apply pressure to tape to secure bond. Apply Silicone to edge in an evenly distributed fashion. If necessary use a putty knife to spread and scrape off excess Silicone. Remove tape.

Optional step: routing a "V" groove into the edge of the Lumicor sheet that will provide a reservoir for the Silicone to dry. Once Silicone is applied a putty knife can be used to scrape excess off for a flush finish.

Note, this is not considered a cosmetic look and framing should be used.

Do

• After taping front and back surface apply pressure to tape so polyurethane won't bleed onto front and back surfaces.

Don't

- Stack sheets and seal.
- Use in a dusty area.
- Use Alcohol or wet rag to clean edges
